

It is once again the time of year our church council turns its hearts and minds to setting the budget. This year is a little different than most, without a pastor in place, the financial needs for the year are uncertain.

While looking at last year's budget and what is to come for next year, it was noticed that the monthly income from giving is significantly less than in the past. The chart below shows: General fund income in green, expenses in yellow and budgeted income in blue. This chart does not reflect giving that was given to a specific project or fund. As you can see income and expenses fluctuate throughout the year with some months higher and some lower. There are also spikes in some months. Giving spikes are due to extra gifts and expense spikes are due to bills that only come once a year.

January 2023

**2022** was Eidsvold's 4<sup>th</sup> year of hosting the West Shore Toys for Kids (WSTK). We returned to our original, "pre-Covid" model of offering a "Toy Store" for families in need of the West Shore at our local QRU Building. We created a festive atmosphere with a sparkling Christmas tree, holiday music & décor surrounded by hundreds of toys, books &

games tended to by cheerful elves dressed for the occasion and wrapping furiously on

the sidelines for three straight days!

Each family chose several gifts for their children, including a book and warm knitted item per child, and stocking stuffers for all. A parent did not leave without receiving a mug for themselves

filled with goodies & a gingerbread kit for their family to decorate. Everyone was very grateful and appreciative. More than 15 great volunteers helped put presents under the trees of 30 local families with multiple gifts for 75 children. Thank you to all who participated in this worthy community event...whether you donated a gift, hauled a gift, or wrapped a gift! There are several factors which affected this program in 2022, so we are truly grateful we were able to offer it at all. The WSTK has been a community program of Lakeside since 1998 and is still continually evolving to meet the needs of local families. We partnered with the several local businesses and organizations who collected toys during the season, and community members were invited to drop off donations during the Chamber's Christmas Tree lighting event in Lakeside. We currently have a committee mixed with four Eidsvold congregation members and 3 local community members. All are welcome to join the team when we start

planning in early 2023 for our next giving season.


